- State Route 940 between Hillside Drive and Christine Road
- Christine Road between State Route 409 and Harleigh Boulevard

CURRENT OCCUPANT

UGI Utilities is committed to providing safe and reliable energy services and invests hundreds of millions of dollars every year in upgrades to our natural gas system. These improvements will include work in your area scheduled to begin in April. The planned system upgrades will impact these streets:

- State Route 940 between Hillside Drive and Christine Road
- Christine Road between State Route 409 and Harleigh Boulevard

Please refer to the map on the reverse side.

What to expect:

- During typical construction hours of 7 am to 5 pm, there may be lane restrictions, detours, and traffic delays. Please speak with a foreman on site if your vehicle or exit is inaccessible during construction.
- Colored flags or markings on the ground where work will take place.
- UGI natural gas customers along the route will experience brief service interruptions during construction. UGI will schedule a date to have access inside your home or business to relight equipment.
- If your meter is currently located inside, UGI will work with you to find a new location outside. Outside meters help provide safer service, in the event natural gas needs to be quickly shut off. UGI will schedule a time to discuss meter placement when we are in your area to do the work.

Not a customer?

You may be eligible to convert to natural gas service during the construction process. Please visit www.ugi.com/digs or scan the QR code with your smartphone camera. Act now to access the savings and benefits of natural gas, **PLUS get extra savings** with a **FREE gas service line installation** when you replace your current heating equipment with natural gas. Please note this offer is subject to normal conditions of construction and installation and restrictions as defined in the Extension Regulation section of the UGI Utilities – Gas Division Tariff (<https://www.ugi.com/tariffs>).



If you were previously a UGI Utilities customer and it has been more than two years since your account was active or the meter has been removed, the service line to your property will be severed during this work. If you wish to reactivate your service, please call UGI at 800-276-2722 before work begins.

Temporary restoration of the road, sidewalks, and grass will be completed immediately after underground work is finished. Final restoration may not be possible for several weeks due to ground settlement, scheduling, and weather conditions. Additional time may also be required for restoration efforts because asphalt paving, pouring concrete, and grass seeding are not successful during winter months.


UGI will notify you again as we prepare for construction. We will make every effort to minimize disruptions during construction and we appreciate your patience as we complete this important work.
